Position Title: Operator 2 – Wells (Entry Level)
Work Location: Slave Lake, Alberta (Mitsue Plant)
Department: Manufacturing
Title of manager this position reports to: Plant Superintendent
Positions reporting to this role: N/A
Work Rotation (if applicable): Shift rotations vary from 5 days on and 2 days off or 14 days on and 7 off, 4 days on and 4 days off.
Work Days / Hours: Day shift/ Night shift required. Days and hours may vary depending on the needs of the business. Generally an 8-12 hour shift.
Purpose of Role: Supports the liquid plant, responsible for the operation of the pipeline Brine Wells and Disposal Well.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complies with all regulatory, environmental and safety rules and standards, as well as company policies.
- Report operations data and any observations of abnormal conditions to direct supervisor.
- Pipeline maintenance projects such as pigging operations, startups, shutdowns and routine maintenance.
- Assists with and monitors various flow control equipment.
- Well site housekeeping.
- As required exchange information regarding pipeline operations, maintenance, measurement, and other activities with direct supervisor, senior managers and company executives.
- Ensure product quality adheres to company standards.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS, WORK EXPERIENCE, SKILLS

- Valid Class 5 driver license.
- Completion of high school, GED or equivalent.
- 2 years related industry experience is required.
- Good verbal and written communication skills.
- Must be a self- starter and possess the ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Strong commitment to safety and environmental.
- Experience in working with valves, filters, blowers, pumps, etc.
- Experience with Programmable Logic Control (P.L.C.) systems.
- Application of formulas to estimate or calculate flow rates and volumes.
- Valid Safety tickets - H2S, Confined Space, First Aid, and Fall Protection.
- Experience with 2 way radios.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS / WORK CONDITIONS

- The work is typically performed outdoors. Exposure to conditions such as extreme heat or cold is likely. Incumbents in this position must be able to physically and legally operate company vehicles and equipment. Must be able to perform work which requires walking, standing, sitting, bending, stooping, heavy lifting (50 lbs), and climbing, including steps and vertical ladders. Personal protective equipment including but not limited to safety glasses, safety shoes, and flame resistant clothing is required.
- Employees must be willing to travel and work extended hours on short notice. Working outside in adverse conditions.

This Position Description in no way states or implies that these are the only core responsibilities to be performed by the employee occupying this position. Employees will be required to perform any other job-related duties assigned by their supervisor. All safety sensitive positions will require pre-employment drug and alcohol screening.
